## **Requirements for Chemistry Laboratory Reports**

- Final report and prelab must be neat, clear, and readable, or they will be rejected as incomplete.
- Prelab includes Heading, Research Question, Hypothesis, Theory, Materials, Method, and Safety.
- Use the stapler and square up the pages before you staple them. Trim off spiral-notebook edges.
- IF I HAVE TO DO SECRETARIAL WORK, YOU WILL LOSE POINTS.
- A lab report will NOT be accepted unless ALL sections below are included and complete!
- Parts can be word-processed, BUT DO YOUR OWN WORK.

**Heading** WRITE OUT the FULL LAB TITLE, LAB Number, Student NAME and DATE.

Work without a name gets thrown away.

**Research Question** A question that the lab addresses, in a complete sentence.

**Hypothesis** Educated guess at expected results.

**Theory** Explanation or scientific reason for the expected results.

**Materials** A list of ingredients and equipment used. Be specific, include sizes.

**Method** A NUMBERED list of the steps in the procedure that sounds like a recipe.

Use short, complete sentences.

**Data Collection** Organized observations, with UNITS. May be text, lists, diagrams, or tables.

& Processing Include what was done with the data, like calculations or graphs.

**Conclusion** Answer questions included with the lab, in complete sentences.

**Application** What did you PERSONALLY learn? How can a specific person use the ideas in

this lab? (Example: "I learned how to use a buret. A cook could use

neutralization to reduce the acidity of tomato sauce.")

## LAB GRADING

- 1. Everyone at your ENTIRE LAB TABLE will lose 10 points each time I have to ask ANYone at that table to wear their eye protection!! Everyone at your ENTIRE LAB TABLE will lose 10 points each time I have to clean up your lab station. (Toss all trash, wipe up spills, return equipment to the right places, no trash in sink.)
- 2. Each lab report is worth 100 points toward your total for that marking period. A lab grade of 50 means the lab was complete, had NO corrections, was on time, done safely (no goggle penalty), and lab station left clean.
- 3. Lab reports must neatly and CLEARLY written on LOOSE LEAF paper, or word-processed. No spiral rip outs! I will not accept raggedy, unprofessional work!
- 4. Incomplete, unprofessional, incorrectly formatted, or otherwise unacceptable lab reports WILL NOT BE GRADED. They will be returned marked "Inc" (incomplete). The student must then revise and re-submit the report. There will be a 15 point (30%) penalty for incomplete or late labs.
